<u>Scholarship Programs</u> - Our "Voice of Democracy" audio-essay program provides high school students with the unique opportunity to express themselves in regards to a democratic and patriotic-themed recorded essay. Each year, nearly 40,000 9-12 grade students from across the country enter to win their share of \$2 million in educational scholarships and incentives awarded through the program. This year's theme is "Why our Vote Matters". The National 1<sup>st</sup> place winner receives a \$30,000 scholarship paid directly to the recipient's American university, college or vocational/technical school. There are also many local, District and State Scholarship Program winners.

Our "Patriot's Pen" youth essay attracts over 132,000 students in grades 6-8 to submit their essays. The national 1<sup>st</sup> place winner wins \$5,000 and an all-expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C. the 1<sup>st</sup> place winner from each state competes for national awards totaling \$54,500, with each 1<sup>st</sup> place state winner receiving a minimum of \$500 at the national level. The essay contest encourages young minds to examine America's history, along with their own experiences in modern American society, by drafting a 300-400 word essay. This years theme is "Why I honor the American Flag."
