<u>St. Patrick's Day Parade:</u> The Union County St. Patrick's Day Parade will be held on Saturday March 9th 2024. We'll meet at our Veteran's Center at 10:00am.

As in past years transportation to and from the Kenilworth Veterans Center will be provided with buses departing for the parade from the KVC at 11:00am and returning to the KVC 15 minutes after the parade ends. Parade start time will be at 1:00pm sharp in Union, NJ. The rain date will be March 23rd.

The Union County Emerald Society and the Elizabeth police and fire departments will be holding their after parade party at the KVC starting after the end of the parade at 2:00pm.
